

## Construction Detour Notice



Construction is set to start on the renovation of the historic Kiddie Brush and Toy building in Downtown Jonesville. The early phases of construction will require the partial closure of the alley along the north side of the building.

During the closure, one-way traffic will be maintained on the western two-thirds of the alley. Customers to Saucy Dogs, the Andrew Mack Brush Company and County National Bank (including the bank drive-through) will need to enter from the West Street entrance to the alley.

The usual two-way traffic will be maintained in the portion of the alley located behind the Sauk Theater, Shear Magic, My Buddies Clip Joint and the Post Office.

The partial closure will begin the week of July 20<sup>th</sup> and will continue for six to eight weeks while crews repair masonry and windows.

Environmental crews are currently working inside the building and demolition of the metal building additions is expected to begin on July 15<sup>th</sup>.

The renovated building will be known as the Heritage Lane Apartments. The building will house 44 one- and two-bedroom apartments. The renovation is being completed by the property owner, Excel-Sterling LDHA of Beachwood, Ohio. The entire renovation is expected to be complete in 12 to 18 months.
