



Why did I get a Winter Property Tax bill from Fayette Township???

Owners of property in the City of Jonesville have recently received winter property tax bills from Fayette Township. These tax bills are the **final bills** that City of Jonesville taxpayers will receive from Fayette Township. These bills are for property that is owned and located within the Jonesville city limits.

But I thought once Jonesville incorporated as a City, the City would collect my taxes?

The winter tax bills are based on assessments that occurred in early 2014, prior to Jonesville city incorporation. Incorporation became effective following voter approval at the August 2014 general election. Fayette Township remains responsible for property assessments and tax collection through the end of 2014.

When will the City begin assessing property and collecting all property taxes?

The City of Jonesville will become responsible for assessing and tax collection on January 1, 2015. After that date, owners of property located in the City of Jonesville will receive property tax bills from the City and will pay all property taxes at City Hall. Taxpayers will receive two tax bills through the year for each property that they own, rather than the three that they received in the past.

I own property in Fayette Township. Where will I pay those taxes?

Owners of property located in Fayette Township will continue to pay property taxes to Fayette Township.
